**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**ADDITIONAL DUTY FREE ALLOWANCE FOR PASSENGERS 18 YEARS AND OVER**

- (1) 50 cigars / 1 carton (200 sticks) cigarettes.
- (2) 1 litre or one quart of spirits (including liqueurs and cordials).
- (3) 1 litre or one quart of wine.

**Prohibited /Restricted Goods**

- The importation of controlled drugs and utensils used therewith, is absolutely prohibited.
- The importation of firearms, ammunition and explosives is prohibited unless accompanied by the prescribed permit issued in Jamaica.
- Fruits, vegetables, plants and live animals may be imported only if the owner is in possession of a valid permit issued in Jamaica.

ALL GOODS I (WE) HAVE PURCHASED OR ACQUIRED ABROAD AND AM(ARE) BRINGING TO JAMAICA OR SUBSEQUENTLY RE-IMPORTING ARE LISTED BELOW
